Mitigating foreign interference is a collective responsibility. The ANU has introduced a new reporting system in order to protect the interests of the university, individual staff and students and more broadly, the national interest.



ANU students and staff are now required to report foreign arrangements related to their work and studies in everything from contracts and grants to student exchanges, advisory roles, paid or honorary appointments and philanthropy.



We know international connections add value to our research, and we want that to continue. We just have to manage any potential risks, together.
